Toft Shop shopping scheme

With the new guidance recommendations from Government regarding social distancing that relate to those over 70, those with pre-existing health conditions and pregnant women, we would like to suggest the following shopping scheme.

We are prepared to put together newspaper and/or grocery deliveries within Toft and other nearby villages, and request volunteers who will deliver in their own village. It will work like this:-

1. Customer contacts shop by phoning us (01223 262204) or email (info@toftshop.co.uk) with name, address, telephone no. and list of goods needed.
2. We will pack the order up and advise of cost, any goods not in stock or if a substitute is available.
3. Deliveries will be made to door of customer by volunteer driver. Any driver over 70 who wishes to pick from shop themselves, must remain in car and shopping will be placed in boot.
4. PAYMENT can made by:-
 - a) Card payment over phone and receipt included with shopping. (We are not permitted by law to retain this information) or we can set up a pre-payment account.
 - b) Cash – prior to delivery we will contact customer who can pass envelope with cash through letter box to volunteer driver.
 - c) Bank transfer via internet payment direct to Toft Shop bank account details that we can supply.
 - d) Cheque payment, with an additional £1.50 extra to cover commercial bank cheque charge.
