2. Planning

2.1. Old Farm House, Tinkers Lane proposed alterations and specifically the safety of the proposed road access:

The only point felt required to be discussed by the present Councillors was the new proposed road access. All confirmed in essence they believed the proposed new location of the driveway would be safer offering better visibility for both users, specifically cyclists, of the highway as well as the residents as they enter and exit the property. Concern was raised about the impact that the electricity and telephone lines appeared to be directly in the middle of the new driveway may have on residents when it was moved, as well as the number of mature trees which would need to be felled, which MW was to raise only as a comments on the planning portal.

It was confirmed in the planning application that the existing driveway will need to be blocked off as part of the conditions of planning.
