## 2. Planning Application

Planning Application No 24/03621/HFUL – Old Farm House, Tinkers Lane, Kingston, Cambridgeshire.

The Councillors considered the application for alterations including 3 new windows, new bathrooms, stairs and new road access which relocated the access driveway away from the corner on Tinkers Lane to an area of straight road in Tinkers Lane.

This application was a re-submission of a previous application No 21/02337/HFUL that appears to have expired. It was felt that moving the entrance driveway to the straighter area of road away from the current corner location was a benefit for safety concerns. The council did not have any comments on the internal alterations suggested.

The council's decision was neutral.

3. Planning Application No 24/1098/TTCA – West View, Church Lane, Kingston, Cambridgeshire

As SD lives next to the property, she was not involved in the parish council discussions relating to this application and did not vote on this application.

The council discussed the application to carry out tree works to reduce the height and width of two trees – one at front of property and the other at the rear. As there are overhead cables in the area it was felt this work was beneficial.

The council's decision was support.
